

A reception with the artists will follow the concert. Be sure to join us for this exciting event!



Friday Ap<mark>ril 3rd</mark> 10:00 AM Barbara Kaskinen will present a program on the topic of inputting musical notation on the computer as well as an introduction to how she teaches beginning composition. She will talk about using a computer notation program and other creative ideas as tools for inspiration and motivation. We will then work with Finale, learning how to set up the layout of the composition, notation input, expression marks, and as many "extras" as we can cover during the session.

She will have handouts with beginning exercises and instructions

and teachers will be able to try the program on the computer a bit themselves. You will find out that the basics are very easy to do. We will not get into symphonic or other types of scores, but rather, work with simple piano scores.

Teachers will be able to download a free introductory finale program at home after finding out how to begin this most useful software for our current times. Then, later, some may decide to purchase the full software program. She hopes to get you excited about this, as it is such a useful addition to a studio.


