We need to find ways to relate to them in their language. One way is through the use of technology in our studios.

I can hardly keep up with the daily changes in technology. For example, my iPhone 4 is now considered obsolete. Time for an upgrade. Yes, it can be overwhelming, but it can also be exciting! Anything out of our comfort zones can be both overwhelming and exciting, right?

Three years ago, I could not have predicted that I would be using an iPad in every lesson. I'm not sure when I first heard the term APP (short for application), but I did not embrace the idea immediately. It was a seminar at an FSMTA Conference that persuaded me to put my toe in the water. I can now safely say that I'm completely submerged and the water is fine!

I'd like to respectfully share something that is working very well for me in my studio. If you do not own an iPAD, I would suggest saving up for one which can be written off as a tax expense. Then, download an APP called MUSIC THEORY PRO. This is a great way to start. Watch your student's eyes light up when you say, "We are going to play a game for a couple of minutes using my iPad." More importantly, watch as they IMPROVE right before your eyes in whatever skill you are focusing on. Key Signatures, Ear Training, Note Reading---this APP covers it all and turns learning into an educational game that this generation can relate to.




