- ✓ 2 letters of recommendations, including a letter of recommendation from the applicant's Broward County Music Teachers Association, Inc. (BCMTA) teacher.

In order to receive any awarded scholarship, the following documentation must be forwarded to the Chairperson of BCMTA College Scholarship Committee after completion of the first semester / quarter of studies within 45 days of specified semester/quarter end:

- ✓ Request for Scholarship Award Disbursement
- ✓ Official Copy of college transcript demonstrating successful completion (minimum grade point average of 3.0 or B) of semester/quarter studies with music-related coursework

IMPORTANT: Failure to submit the required documentation and Request for Scholarship Award Disbursement within 45-days of the semester/quarter end will result in forfeiture of the scholarship award.
